<p><b>incarnation</b></p>		<p>Know why Christmas is celebrated by Christians</p> <p>Know that Christians use advent as a time to prepare</p> <p>Know that Christians believe Jesus is God and that he was born as a baby in Bethlehem</p> <p>Know that the bible indicates to Christians that Jesus was extraordinary eg worshipped as a king and came to bring Good news for everyone rich or poor eg shepherds first to hear</p> <p>Explain why Christians view Jesus as a gift to the world</p>	<p>Know that Christians believe Jesus is one of the three persons of the Trinity: God the father, God the Son and God the Holy Spirit.</p> <p>Know that Christians believe the father creates, he sends the son to save the people, the son sends the holy spirit to his followers.</p> <p>Know that Christians believe the holy spirit is God's power at work in the world and in their lives enabling them to follow Jesus.</p> <p>Explain what the term 'incarnation' means and why its important concept for Christians</p> <p>Understand why Jesus' birth is considered good news to Christian</p>	<p>Analyse, compare and contrast the biblical accounts of the birth of Jesus</p> <p>Consider the importance to Christians of the incarnation and apply this when discussing suitable content for a Nativity play.</p> <p>Identify titles given to Jesus in the new and old testament.</p> <p>Analyse why they are appropriate.</p> <p>Know that Christians believe Jesus is the Messiah referred to in the old testament. <p><b>Salvation</b></p>		<p>Know that Easter is important in the big story of the bible.</p> <p>Understand that Jesus showed he was willing to forgive all people even for putting him on the cross.</p> <p>Know Christians believe Jesus builds a bridge between God and humans.</p> <p>Know Christians believe Jesus rose from the dead, giving people new hope.</p>	<p>Recall the main events of the Easter Story</p> <p>Know that the various events of holy week were important in showing the disciples what Jesus came to earth to do</p> <p>Understand why Christians believe Easter happened and why Jesus died</p> <p>Know that Christians see holy week as the culmination of Jesus' earthly life, leading to his death and resurrection.</p> <p>Know that Christians remember and celebrate Jesus' last week, death and resurrection at Easter.</p> <p>Know Christians believe Jesus rose from the dead and so is still alive today</p> <p>Explain the meaning of the terms sin, suffering and sacrifice in the context of Easter.</p> <p>Explain how art and symbolism is used to by Christians in prayer and worship at Easter</p>	<p>Uses the terms resurrection and Salvation</p> <p>Understands how salvation fits into the 'big story' of the bible and why Christians say Jesus died to save them.</p> <p>Know that Christians remember Jesus' sacrifice through Holy Communion</p> <p>Understand that Christians believe through salvation that death is not the end.</p>
